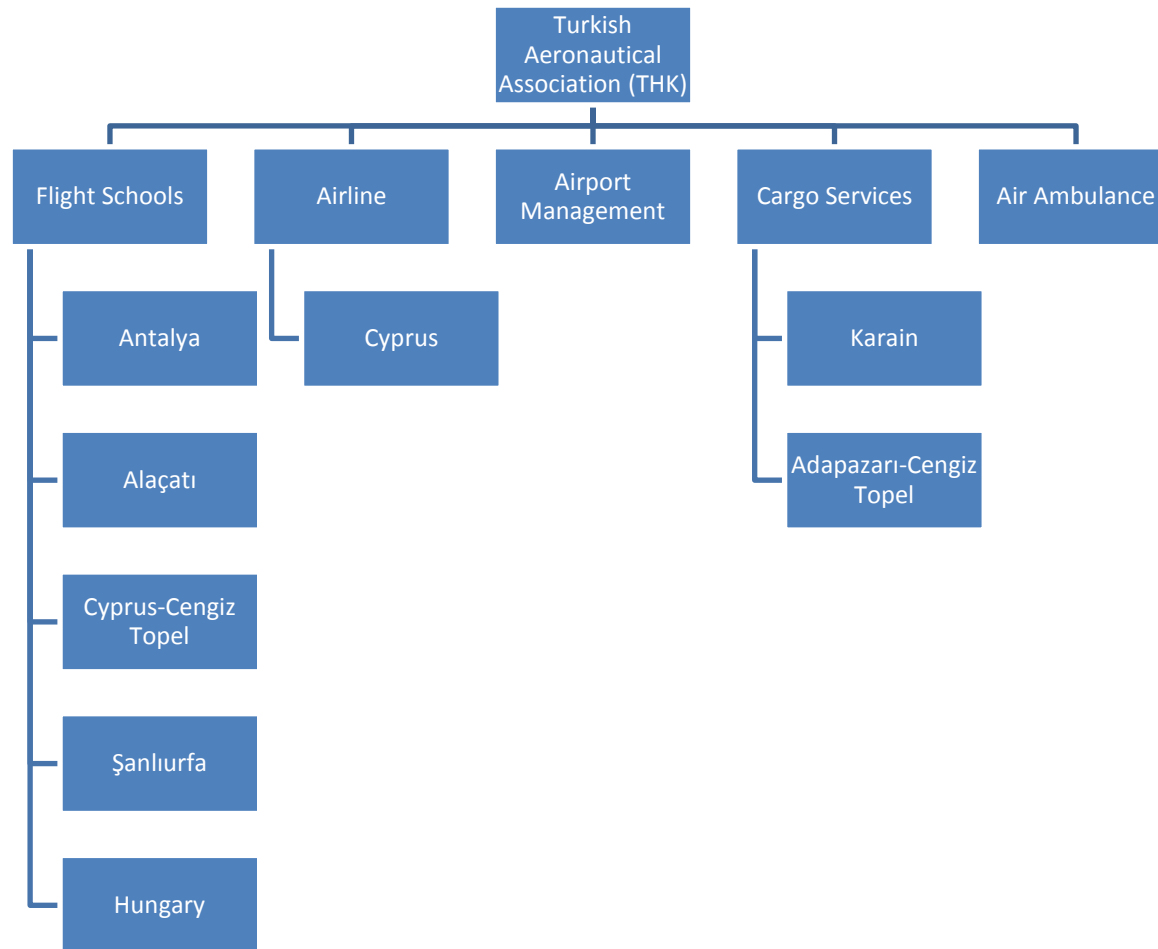

LOCAL & INTERNATIONAL MARKET DEMAND

- Turkish Airlines has a pilot deficit of 600 at present, over 4000 pilots and 10,000 cabin personnel will be hired until the year 2023 according to their plan.
- According to Boeing and Airbus, 600,000 new commercial pilots and 548,000 new technicians will be required between 2014-2033.
